# CSV make a difference

### The Project

Halcon House is a residential centre for adults (18-65yrs) who are physically disabled and/or have a sensory loss. There are up to 3 permanent residents at the house and the remaining residents stay for respite. At full capacity there are 16 residents. The house is very popular and respite bookings are made well in advance.

Halcon House has been using volunteers since 1995 to help throughout the centre, with a focus on providing companionship and social activities.

### Why use CSV volunteers?

"For Halcon House, having CSV volunteers is not a luxury, it's an expectation. Over the past few years, the needs of our clients have increased and staff don't have time to provide for anything beyond their basic needs. If a client has to choose between a respite centre that meets their basic needs, or a respite centre that has extra activities, such as swimming, going to the cinema, or shopping, then the client will choose the latter every time.



Volunteers are very well received by the staff team and during busy times we've been able to call upon them to deal with necessary routine tasks so that staff can focus on more pressing issues. We've also had incredibly good feedback from service users. They understand that having a volunteer means that they can do much more during their stay here and they also love how the volunteers are choosing to spend their time with them.

Having international volunteers gives clients an insight into other cultures. Our volunteers spend as much time with the service users as possible, and we also have a tradition where the volunteer prepares a meal from their home country for all the service users to enjoy.
