Tom's challenge was solved when SEQOL's Reablement team taught him to use online shopping - and then supported him to use his points on great days out!

Tina, has a completely different challenge. Her challenge is not that she has a Learning Disability, but that other people seem to think that means she can't add any value at work.

So no one gives her a job and she struggles to budget, to keep her flat nice and to have much quality of life.

SEQOL Supported Employment has worked with her landlord to give her training, advice, experience and then support on a placement, all the way to employment.

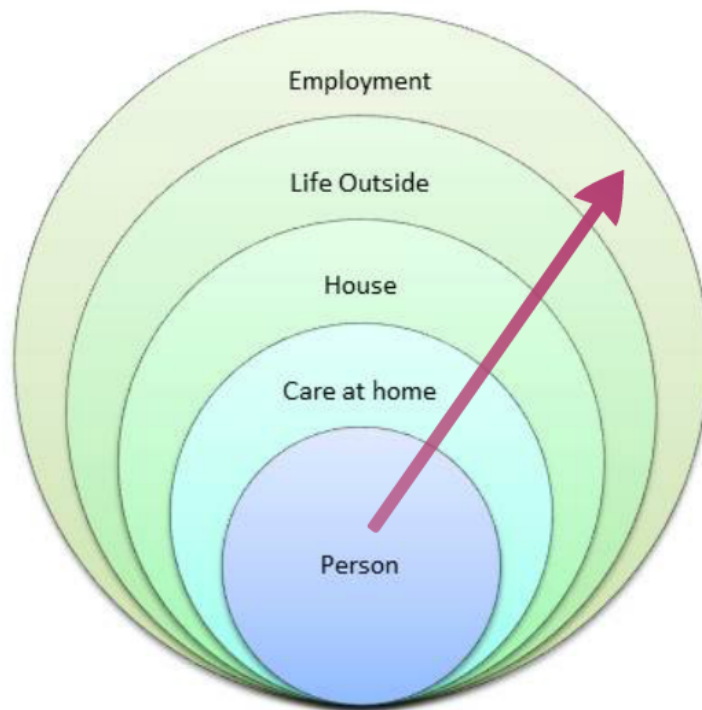
