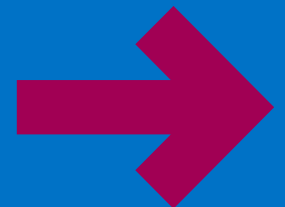

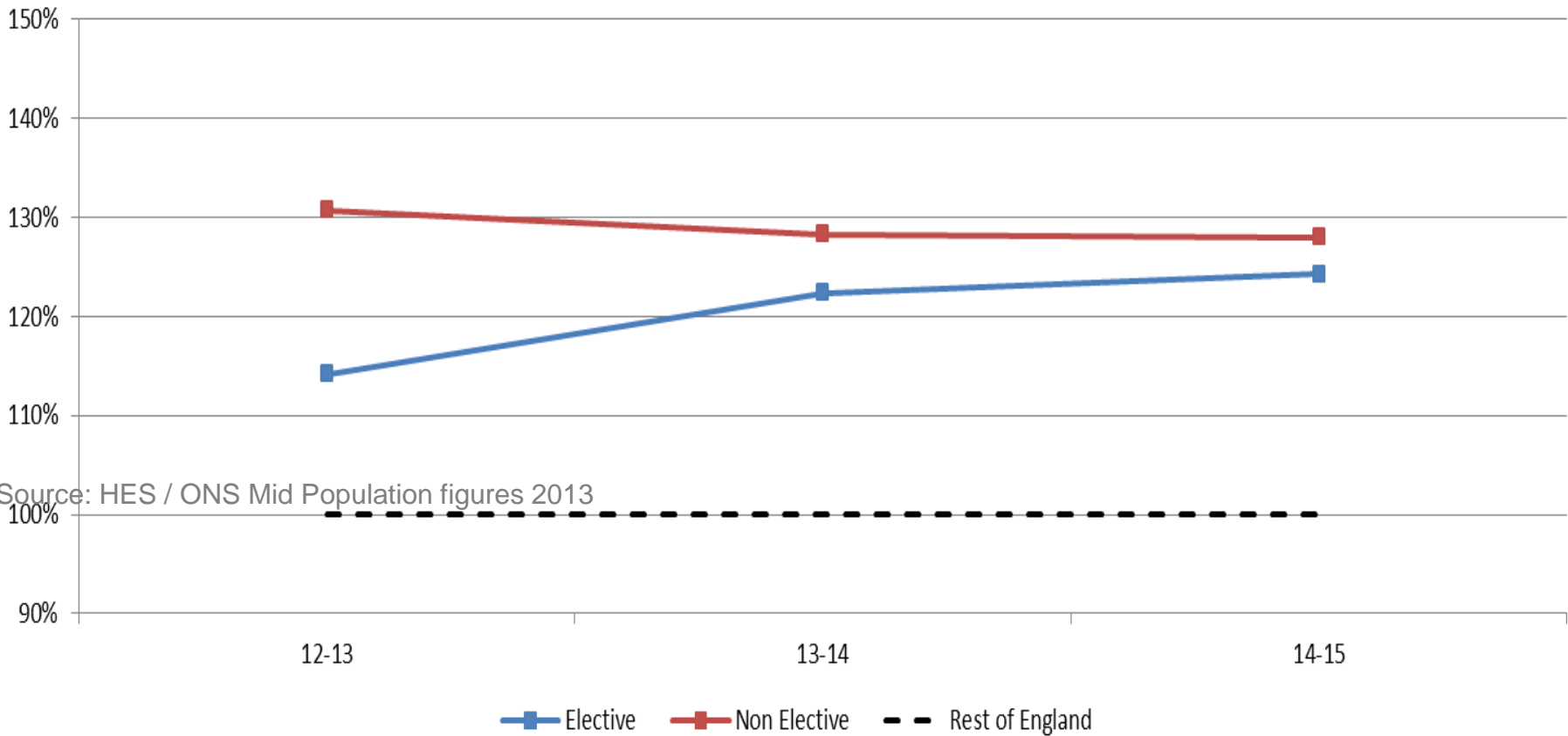
5YFV Challenge and Housing

Higher hospitalisation rates

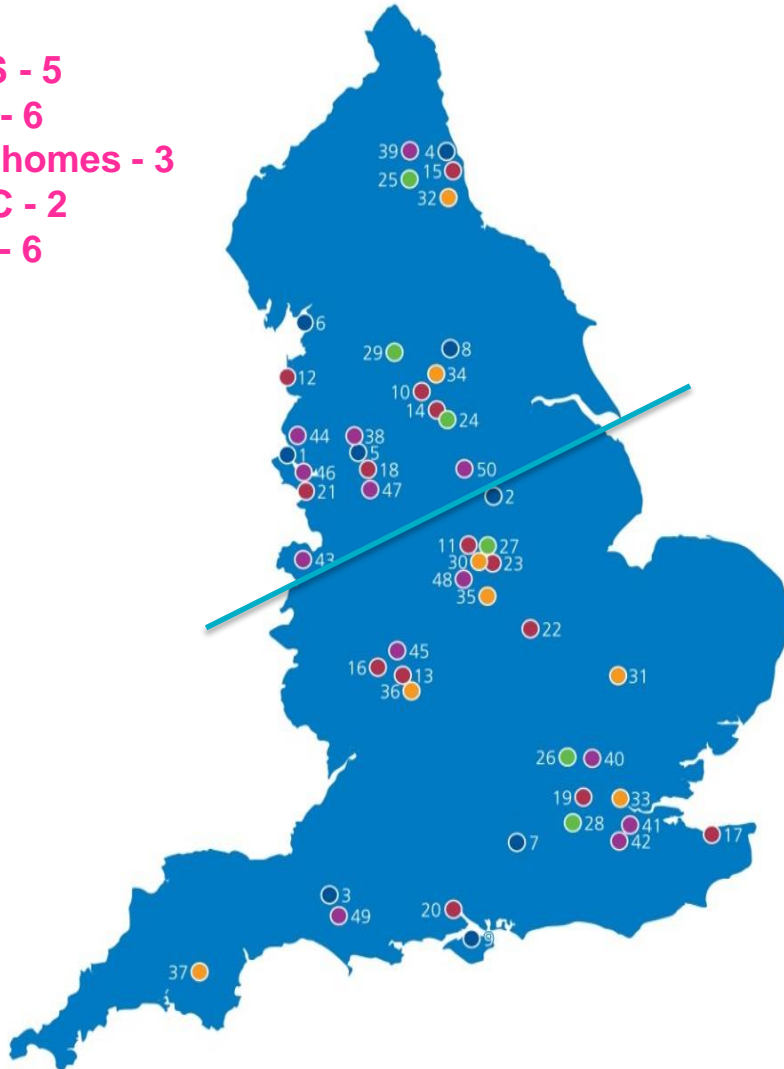
North of England Elective and Non Elective Admissions per 1,000 population compared to the rest of England (based at 100)

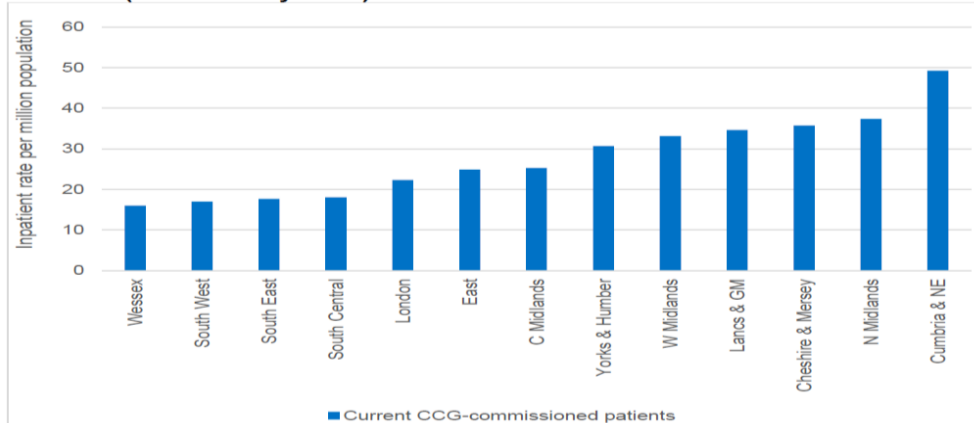


Housing and Health - Learning Disabilities
