

Housing Lin Cymru Annual Symposium Remodelling Sheltered Housing – Addressing the Challenges

- 72 semi-sheltered homes across 3 sites
- 163 sheltered homes across 5 sites
- 88 Extra Care homes across 2 sites

Plus, a significant number of homes designated for older people including self-contained bungalows and apartment blocks.

 Majority of sheltered and semi- sheltered homes built in the 1970's and 1980's and are outdated

This is likely consistent with many social landlords in Wales.

- WHQS implementation grant
- Optimised Retrofit Program
- Housing with Care Fund
- Risk that focus on the "whole" gets lost
