## Older People in Wales






#### An ageing population:

- 21.3% aged 65+ in Wales
- 18.4% aged 65+ in England
- 1% aged 90+
- 13% of people in Wales aged 65+ report bad or very bad health
- 31% limited a lot by longstanding illness




'The cost of living - council tax is still rising. As I'm self-employed I'm worried I won't be able to cope'

- 18% of respondents found isolation and loneliness a challenge
- 66% of those with poor physical health found isolation and loneliness a challenge

'I applied for several positions for which I was qualified and received no replies - I dropped my age by 10 years on my CV and got several replies and a job'

11% discriminated against in the workplace

70% don't think that older people are well represented in society
