PROFESSIONAL ENGAGEMENT AND IMPACT LEAD



The ABAJ team are pleased to share that Jenny Kartupelis has joined the project as the Professional Engagement and Impact lead. She will be facilitating practice and policy change through collaborative approaches.

As a consultant on the project she will be dedicating a day a month to facilitate impact from the research project, providing strategic and operational oversight, she will lead, maintain and develop the Professional advisory group (PAG) to support the team in delivering impact targeting professional audiences to bring about positive change.



CO-ANALYSING INTERVIEW DATA

BRAG members Aminur and Faruk, ABAJ team members Bashir and Leena have joined the OU team to undertake co-analysis of the probin interview transcripts. They first met to identify some codes (emerging themes) together, from which a Codebook has been developed.



In pairs, the team are working through a number of transcripts to apply the codes from the Codebook to each transcript. Firstly, they are reading through the transcripts on their own and coding. Then they are meeting in their pairs to discuss their input and then agree on codes between them. They are also discussing to see if there are any new codes emerging.

PREPARATION IS UNDERWAY FOR FAMILY INTERVIEWS

As the phase of interviews with the 80 individual Probins comes to an end, the ABAJ team are preparing for the 10 interviews with families who live in intergenerational homes.

This preparation requires developing questions to ask the families and thinking about how to find interested families from the four boroughs. Support from BRAG to find the 10 families will be most welcome!
